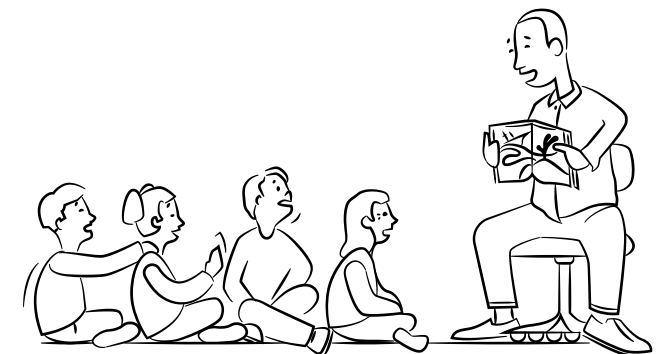

Our community cares deeply for each individual student. Our education is personal because we know our students and help them grow on an individualized path. Our instruction and program are personalized to help each student achieve their best.

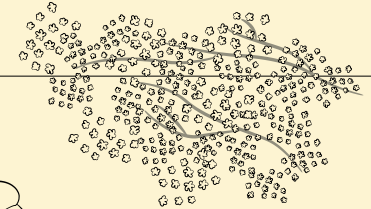
We're invested in the development of the whole student, not just academics. Our program creates opportunity for this, and our teachers live out their devotion to the students daily.

Growing up in Wuhan

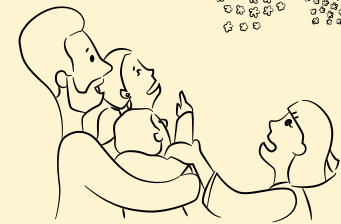
A brief history

2007

We officially changed the name of our school to Wuhan Yangtze International School.

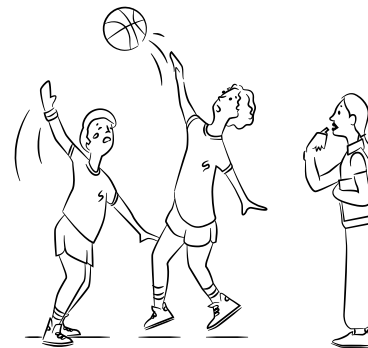


Heart of our team

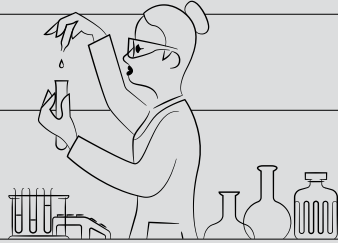

Our Secondary School



Our Secondary program at Wuhan Yangtze International School launches students on a journey of discovery into the world of today and the world they will shape tomorrow. Our accredited course offerings in math, science, language arts, philosophy, social studies and fine arts prepare students to enter universities around the world. Our service projects and leadership initiatives give students the opportunity to develop into dynamic individuals of truth and excellence who contribute positively to society. At Wuhan Yangtze, we learn, love and lead.

Robotics and technology

Our award-winning robotics program for boys and girls in middle school and high school offers them the



opportunity for advanced applied technology education. Combined with our Makerspace, Design Thinking, Coding Club and AP Computer Science classes, these programs prepare our students for the high-tech future.

Advanced Placement® (AP)

High school students in Grades 9–12 have access to a wide variety of AP courses. Providing students with further credits for university, these courses include English, Chinese, economics, human geography, calculus, chemistry, physics, biology and more. In addition to the AP courses offered in person, students have access to several courses offered through LifePlus Online Academy, including the AP

College preparation

Our strong English language instruction, vocabulary development, advanced math progression, and concept-based teaching prepare students for their college entrance exams. Our Learning Support team is committed to giving every child the opportunity to learn and grow. We provide various levels of academic support based on individual student needs. Working closely with teachers and parents, we identify students who need some extra academic and social support in the classroom. Our team then provides tailored support, and regularly checks up on students' progress through the year. The Learning Support office may also refer students for psychoeducational testing and coordinate a team of parents and teachers to develop a student-centered learning plan based on the unique goals and needs of the child.

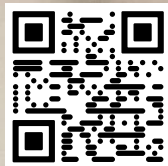
School Counseling

English Language Support

English Language Support (ELS) provides additional support to non-native English-speaking students who are not fluent in English. These students receive personalized care from ELS specialized teachers during key times in our regular classes and during additional ELS classes.
